

PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING A WORK RELATED INJURY:

Immediately provide as much information as you can about your injury or illness to your supervisor or departmental designee. This person will submit the requisite forms to the workers' compensation office.

If you require non-emergency medical treatment, this treatment will be provided at:

If you require emergency medical care, you may seek treatment at the closest Emergency Department for your initial care; any additional medical treatment must be obtained through one of the University approved providers.

To ensure that the University of Pittsburgh will pay bills associated with medical treatment, you **must** select from one of the licensed physicians or health care providers listed on the University Health Care Provider Panel.

If the on-the-job injury involves a Bloodborne pathogens exposure (such as a needle stick, contaminated sharp, blood/body fluid splash, etc.), or involves an animal or occurs in an animal facility medical treatment must be obtained by:
