

CHEMICAL WASTE DISPOSAL

DO

- Routinely dispose of waste chemicals through EH&S
 "Chemical Waste Program."
- Label all containers with a completed chemical waste label & identify constituents.
- Only purchase the amount of chemicals that you need.

- Segregate chemicals/waste into compatible groups.
- Keep containers closed and utilize secondary containment when transporting or handling.

DON'T

- DO NOT stockpile unused chemicals.
- DO NOT dispose of chemical waste in the sanitary sewer/drain.
- DO NOT dispose of chemical waste in the regular trash.



 DO NOT place chemical waste in biological waste boxes or biohazard bags.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Waste chemicals are picked up from University buildings on a bi-weekly schedule.
- If your building does not have a standard collection point, pickup arrangements can be made by contacting EH&S at 412-624-9505.
